## MCCA Elections Results

The Board of Directors and I thank all our residents for the amazing voter turnout in this important election. Almost 50% of our units were represented in this vote, which is the largest voter turnout seen in MCCA history. It is an honor and pleasure to work in an Association with so many engaged residents.

We also thank the many volunteers who went door-to-door, talked to their neighbors, and increased awareness of the importance of participating in this election. It is obvious that our residents care deeply about the future of our community.

Our Governing Documents (Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, Article IV, section 4.3) state that votes are weighted according to the percentage of the assessment paid by each unit as follows:

- Single-family units have 1 vote per unit
- Townhomes have .75 votes per unit
- Condos and Apartments have .5 votes per unit.

The final ballot count is as follows:

#### Total units represented in vote = 1809

#### Total weighted ballots cast = 1304
