### **Open Meeting:**

Based on evidence obtained by MCCA staff and the police report describing the incident on November 2, 2022, the Board has determined that:

- The conduct of the residents at ST 57, including the incident on November 2, 2022, is a nuisance to the neighborhood and is a violation of MCCA Restrictive Covenants section 7.1.3.
- ST 57 is being run as a Boarding House in violation of the MCCA Restrictive Covenants sections 7.9.4, 7.9,6, and 7.9.7.
- The owner of ST 57 has failed to truthfully report her tenants on the Tenant Information Form as required by the MCCA Restrictive Covenants section 7.9.10.
- The owner of ST 57 did not evict tenant Chris Jantz by September 30 and the \$1250 fine MCCA forgave when the owner wrongfully reported that her tenant moved, is reinstated.

**Motion:** Due to the Board's findings, we move to take legal action against ST 57 and use every tool provided within our Restrictive Covenants to resolve the issue. **Motion by:** Kristi Zevenbergen, **Second by:** Judy Cromwell, **Passed** Unanimously.
