Chatham West Light Project

Over the last 20 years, MCCA has brought light to the entries of our single-family home divisions. The last division will finally receive electricity this year. We thank the residents of Chatham West for their patience as we worked with PUD and our vendors to find a solution for this entry. On July 15 we expect to start the project and hope to complete it by the end of July.

Chopper Park Sealant

The Chopper Park parking lot will be sealed and re-stripped this summer. Sealing asphalt extends its useful life so this is a regular maintenance project. We expect this project to happen sometime in August.

Wildflower Stormwater Pond Cleanout

We will remove a few decades of debris from the Wildflower Stormwater Pond this summer. We will use the same vendor (Currey Construction) we used for the Cherry Pond Stormwater Pond cleanout. Currey Construction is also working on the Chatham West Light project and this project will be completed in tandem with that. We expect this project to start mid-July.

MCCA Office Paint

The MCCA Office is already 10 years old and it is time to touch up the exterior paint. Fortunately, the paint on the body of the office is still in really good shape, the wooden trim pieces are the parts that need attention. We are working with Performance Painting who will do a soft wash and then freshen up the paint on the trim to ensure we get as much life out of our wooden trim pieces as possible.
