

Chatham West Light Project

Over the last 20 years, MCCA has brought light to the entries of our single-family home divisions. The last division will finally receive electricity this year. We thank the residents of Chatham West for their patience as we worked with PUD and our vendors to find a solution for this entry. We started on July 14 and hope to have the project completed in early August.


Chopper Park Sealant

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
Wildflower Stormwater Pond Cleanout


Wildflower Park storm pond before the cleanout.
